## Mdina – The City of Noble Families

Mdina, a tentative UNESCO World Heritage Site, is also known as the Silent City, Citta Notabile (Notable City), Citta Vecchia (Old City) and Medina. It is considered as one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the world with its astonishing mix of baroque and medieval architecture, wonderfully adorned churches and palaces that make this silent city an outdoor museum. Experience the noble life at Palazzo Bifora Boutique Hotel hidden away amidst the oldest alleyways and fortifications and set in a design reminiscent of colonial times. Palazzo Bifora's six suites are ideal for family reunions with an unforgettable backdrop.

DAY 1: Arrival in Malta. Private Transfer in our Luxury vehicles to Palazzo Bifora in Mdina (Hotel not included, on request).

Settle in to the Palazzo Bifora and look forward to have the first cheers of this family reunion with welcome drinks and finger food during the evening (not included, on request).

DAY 2: Private Sailing Boat Cruise [Full day, Any day return transport, Bbq lunch with drinks, skipper, fuel, snorkels, WC included]

Start your experience in Malta with a private sailing boat charter on a Valentina S yacht for the entire family (12 pax) with a luxurious sailing trip along Malta, Comino and Gozo's picturesque coastline. Your skipper will stop for swimming breaks in the best locations where you can use the provided snorkels and stand up paddle boats. You will also be served with a BBQ lunch including drinks.

DAY 3: Full Day Guided Tour of Valletta & Mdina including Karozzin ride (Any day, Private tour, Transport, no lunch)

Our guided tour through the vibrant streets of Valletta will allow you to discover the beauty and charm of the fortified city built by the Knights in 1566. The Order of St. John ruled over the islands for 268 years and left a unique cultural legacy of which Valletta is the prime example. We first enjoy a breathtaking view of the Grand Harbour from the Upper Barracca Gardens. Then we visit St. John's Co-Cathedral, including the Caravaggio masterpieces in the Oratory. The Co-Cathedral houses one of the most beautiful marble inlaid floors in the world. Going down Republic Street you will walk past the Grand Masters' Palace and the recently restored St. George's Square.

In the afternoon we will visit Malta's medieval city of Mdina for a guided tour and walk along the narrow, winding streets, dating back to the Arab period. On the way there, you will discover different styles of architecture, including the medieval Siculo-Norman palaces, and other baroque buildings of great historical importance. Time stands still in this 'Silent City' which is a film-maker's paradise. Finally, you will be











chauffeured around the Mdina fortifications in a Karozzin - a horse drawn carriage and the only vehicle allowed inside the Silent City - for a 45 minute drive to take in the sights, sounds and smells of the Mdina Experience.
